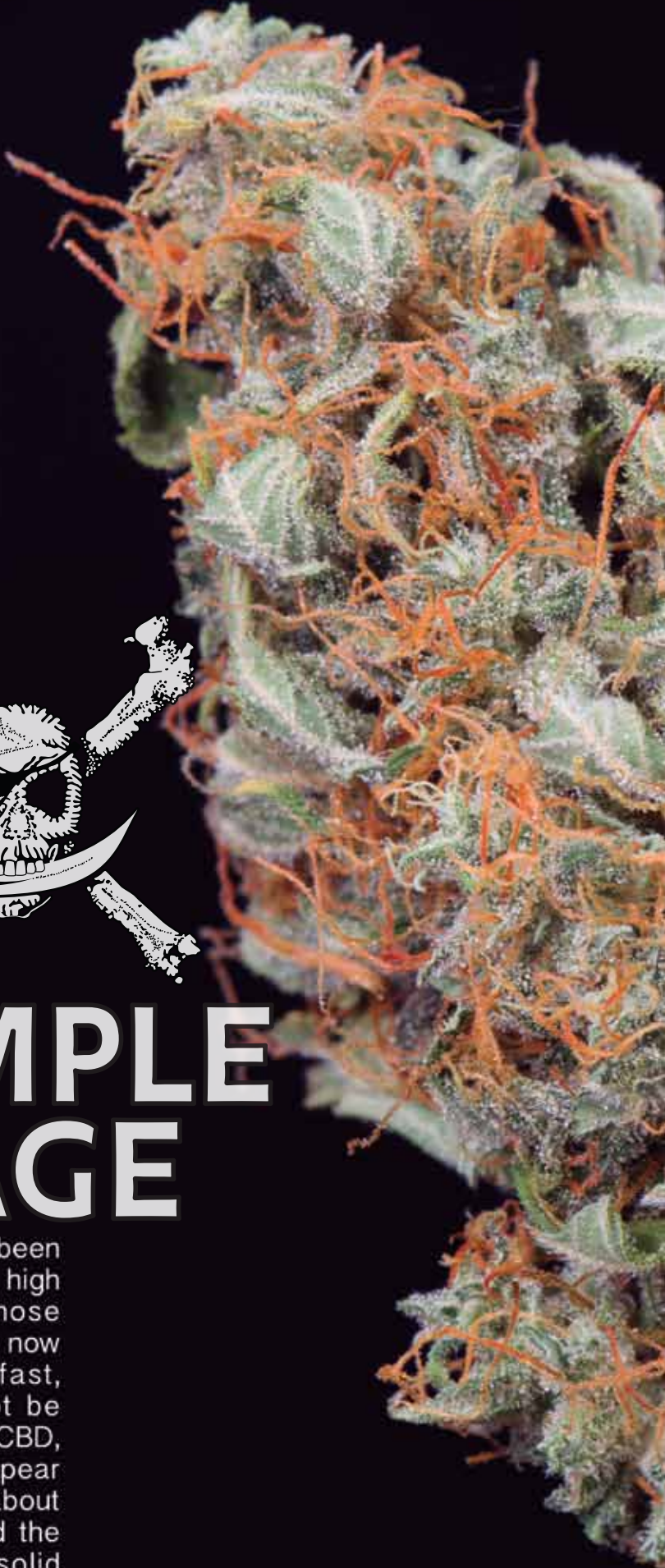

**FEBRUARY 2016** marks another significant milestone in our collective drive for change, as one of the toughest nuts finally began to crack. Courtesy of years of hard graft, tireless campaigning and endless dedication, patients in Australia can finally choose to medicate with 'home grown' medicinal cannabis without falling on the wrong side of the law. The wonderful land 'Down Under' has often been seen as one of the fiercest opponents of any form of decriminalization, but the Commonwealth has now been blessed with a decision to allow medicinal cannabis to be grown by localized sources, thereby paving the way for a new chapter in Australian healthcare. Last year, there was a focus by the media on the case of one particular young man, Daniel Haslam, who suffered horrendously due to his terminal cancer during his last few months of life; his family was very vocal in his support of using marijuana to reduce his nausea and also as an incredibly effective painkiller. With numerous patients currently undergoing treatment, this new law is a ray of hope in their darkest hour.

Ushering in this change, in the form of The Narcotic Drugs Amendment Bill 2016, is the result of a bi-lateral party decision in both houses of parliament. As we are seeing more frequently, politicians are listening to the people and working in the best interests of those they have been elected to represent (democracy is great, when it's done properly) and, if this is anything to go by, 2016 may well continue to build on the global success stories of last year. It is clear that Australia is ready to reap the benefits of cannabis as they attempt to harvest the true potential of it in relation to scientific research and medical treatments. Cost implications of importing medicines from

global sources must have been a key factor in moving towards the new legislation, with there being an opportunity to save vast amounts of investment by 'cutting out the middle man' (or should that be trimming?). It makes perfect sense; Australia's climate is well-suited to cultivation of outdoor cannabis, which should ensure excellent harvests from well-managed crops, and there are many who are hoping that this is a 'foot in the door' for future developments with regards to relaxed laws so that they can grow their own medicine at some point (although they most certainly are happy with this development as it stands, for now).

## THE SMOKE TEST

When we are trying a new strain for the first time, we like to test this in as many different ways as possible to get the best effects. So, for the Big Kush we tested the flowers in a vaporizer, water bong and in joint form. For me, the best flavor was delivered through the vaporizer, so that is what I used more. For a faster onset of effects, pure joints or used in a bong was most effective. The Big Kush burned to a nice clean white ash, which tells me the plants were grown well and very little extra growth nutrients were left in the end product.

The smoke on the inhale was very smooth and all kush with a light spicy pepper taste. The full flavor came through on the exhale; you can taste the fruit of the Critical+ and a slight earthy background taste. The smoke expansion in the lungs was very light on the chest and the onset of effects was very fast from this strain - around 5-10 minutes for a nice cerebral, uplifting high which lasted for a good couple of hours.

We smoked the Big Kush for over 3 weeks and it was a great all around smoke. If smoked in moderation it was a great strain for pain relief, anxiety and depression. If needed though, this strain did have the capability to knock you out. Especially when smoked pure in joints or water bongs. So super effective for insomnia or if you just need to relax and forget about the world.

If you like your kush strains but want something with a bit extra flavor and bigger yield with no decrease in quality from the original OG Kush then I would definitely recommend the Big Kush!

From what the grower told me, the yield was increased by 25-30% and all the original flavors have been retained with a slight fruity twist.

Overall, we were very impressed with this strain and it will be making its way into my grow room in the near future.

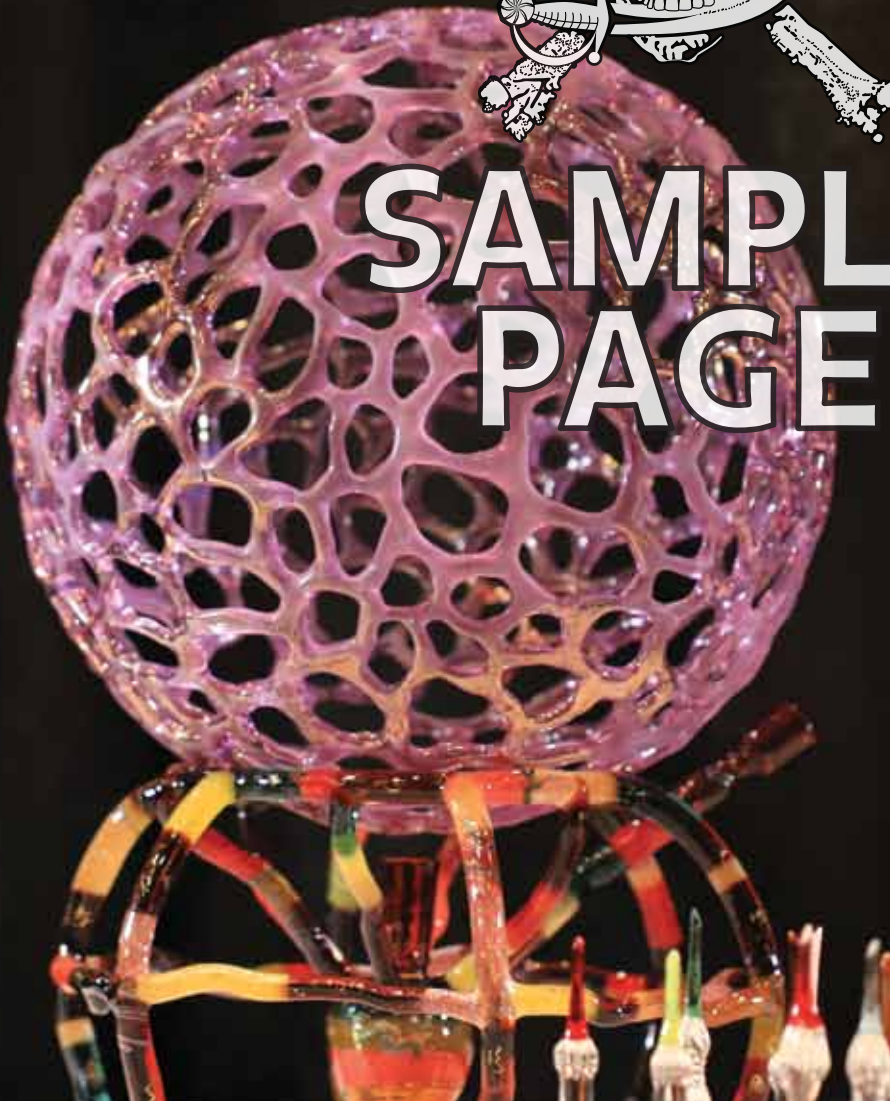
